The topics which will be assessed during the November mock exams are as follows, with the Kerboodle references in brackets:

Biology

1. Cell biology (B1, B2)
2. Organisation (B3, B4)
3. Infection and response (B5, B6, B7)
4. Bioenergetics (B8, B9)

Chemistry

1. Atomic structure and the periodic table (C1, C2)
2. Bonding, structure, and the properties of matter (C3)
3. Quantitative chemistry (C4)
4. Chemical changes (C5, C6)
5. Energy changes (C7)

Physics

1. Energy (P1, P2, P3)
2. Electricity (P4, P5)
3. Particle model of matter (P6)
4. Atomic structure (P7)

1. Start by RAG rating the checklists, focus on the amber topics for your revision to start with and if you have time, progress to the red topics.
2. If you struggle with identifying what you know and what you do not know, complete a past paper, self-mark and identify the topics you have not answered correctly. These past papers and mark schemes will be uploaded to Satchel 1 (show my homework)
3. Start with **reading** the Kerboodle textbook pages, then **watch** the GCSEfreesciencelessons video, finally, **quiz** yourself using Educake.
